Macros

- Short for: "Macro Commands"
 Several commands combined into one
- Can be recorded
- ... and played back



Developer Toolbar

- Used to create and edit macros
- Normally hidden from users

Form Controls

Various tools to aid data input:

- Buttons
- Checkboxes
- Slidebars
- Text boxes
- List boxes
- Combo boxes

VBA Editor

- Tool for editing macros
- Automates repetitive tasks
- VBA: Programming language
 - VBA = Visual Basic for Applications
 - Also available in Word

2 Ways to Store Macros

- In a Workbook
 - Must be saved as a Macro-Enabled Workbook
 - E.g., invoice.xlsm
- On your PC
 - In your Personal Macro Workbook
 - Normally hidden

Array Formulas

- Interacts with several cells at once
- Magic key combination:
 - Not: Enter
 - But: Ctrl + Shift + Enter

3D Maps Chart

- Shows geographical data in 3D
- Examples: Sales for Each State

Interactive Dashboard

Lets executives focus on key variables

Power View Dashboard

 Lets executives focus on key variables with "power tools"

Solver

Finds best combination of several variables to solve a problem
