




GAN



- 624 prompts



- US Copyright Office refused to register a copyright
- Using AI to generate art was a "merely mechanical" process with "no place for novelty, invention, or originality"

What About Photographs?

- Originally, photographs could not be copyrighted
- Napoleon Sarony's portrait of Oscar Wilde, 1882
- Sarony sued to obtain copyright

The Supreme Court:

- Ordinary photos merit no protection
 - "Mere mechanical reproduction"
- But the Wilde photo reflected Sarony's "original mental conception"
 - The costume, background, pose, lighting, etc.



Photography vs AI Art

- Now all photographs are copyrighted
 - Regardless of the work done by photographer

- First, no copyrights







DALL-E 3


- From OpenAI
